ORGANISATION APPROVAL - AOC  
AIRCRAFT**

Based on Article 61 of the Law on Administration ("BiH Official Gazette" no 32/02), in relation to Article 6 and Article 7 of the Aviation Law of BiH ("BiH Official Gazette", no: 02/04), the Director General of the Bosnia and Herzegovina Directorate of Civil Aviation issued:

**REGULATION  
ABOUT  
MAINTENANCE ORGANISATION APPROVAL-  
AOC AIRCRAFT**

**Article 1  
APPLICABILITY**

- 1.1. This Part 6.1 Regulation about maintenance organisation approval – AOC aircraft is issued pursuant to Bosnia Herzegovina AVIATION LAW Article 37.3 and prescribes;
- (1) In paragraph 3, the requirements for the approval of legal entities to perform maintenance on all aircraft and associated components used for commercial flights in accordance with an Air Operators Certificate.
  - (2) In paragraph 4, the requirements for the approval of legal entities to perform maintenance on all small aircraft and associated components with turbine engines used for non-commercial flights.

*Note; The requirements for the approval of legal entities to perform maintenance on small piston engine aircraft used for non-commercial purposes is contained in Bosnia and Herzegovina Aviation Regulation No 6.2.*

**Article 2  
DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1. For the purpose of this regulation, the following definitions shall apply:
- (1) **Small aircraft**; an aircraft having a maximum certificated take-off mass of 5700Kg or less.
  - (2) **Large Aircraft**; an aircraft having a maximum certificated take-off mass over 5700Kg.
  - (3) **Maintenance**; means any one or combination of overhaul, repair, inspection replacement, modification or defect rectification of an aircraft/aircraft component.
  - (4) **Modification**; means the alteration of an aircraft/aircraft component in conformity with an approved standard.
  - (5) **Overhaul**; means the restoration of an aircraft/aircraft component by inspection and replacement in conformity with an approved standard to extend the operational life.
  - (6) **Repair**; means the restoration of an aircraft/aircraft component to a serviceable condition in conformity with an approved standard.
  - (7) **JAA**; means the Joint Aviation Authorities, an associated body of the European Civil Aviation Conference;
  - (8) **JAR**; means the Joint Aviation Requirements of the JAA bearing that number or letters and reference to a numbered or lettered JAR is a reference to such a requirement in the form in which it has been adopted by JAA. For the purpose of this regulation all related materials are included in this definition.

**Article 3**  
**MAINTENANCE ORGANISATION APPROVAL REQUIREMENTS –**  
**ALL AIRCRAFT USED FOR COMMERCIAL AIR TRANSPORT.**

- 3.1. Pursuant to BH AVIATION LAW Article 6.3 the BH DCA adopts JAR 145 as the regulation for the approval of a legal entity to maintain an aircraft and associated components operated under an Air Operators Certificate issued by the BH DCA.

**Article 4**  
**MAINTENANCE ORGANISATION APPROVAL REQUIREMENTS –**  
**AIRCRAFT WITH ONE OR MORE TURBINE ENGINES USED FOR NON-COMMERCIAL PURPOSES.**

- 4.1. Pursuant to BH AVIATION LAW Article 6.3 the BH DCA adopts JAR 145 as the regulation for the approval of a legal entity to maintain a turbine engine aircraft and associated components used for non-commercial purposes.

**Article 5**  
**APPLICATION**

- 5.1. Application for Approval shall be made on BH DCA Form DCA T9-11, copies of which may be obtained from the BH DCA, which when completed in duplicate should be returned.

**Article 6**  
**ASSESSMENT AND ISSUE OF APPROVAL**

- 6.1. The applicant organisation will be assessed for compliance and when satisfied that an applicant meets the requirements of paragraph 4 of this Regulation and the fee paid according to the BH AVIATION LAW Article 37.4, the BH DCA will issue a certificate of approval to the applicant under the provision of the BH AVIATION LAW Article 37.3.
- 6.2. This certificate of approval will include Terms of Approval to define the capability of the holder by listing the types or groups of types of aeroplanes and/or rotorcraft and/or components on which the holder can perform maintenance and release to service.

**Article 7**  
**INTERIM PROVISION**

- 7.1. Approvals issued in accordance with previous legislation shall be replaced with Approvals specified by this Regulation within 180 days as of the date when it enters into force.

**Article 8**  
**FINAL PROVISION**

- 8.1. This Regulation shall enter into force on the eighth day after the publishing date in the “BiH Official Gazette” and it shall also be published in the “Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH” and the “Official Gazette of the Republic of Srpska”.
