Pursuant to Article 16 and Article 61(2) of the Law on Administration (Official Gazette of BIH 32/02 and 102/09) and Article 14(1) of the Aviation Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BIH 39/09), the Director General of the Bosnia and Herzegovina Directorate of Civil Aviation has hereby adopted

RULEBOOK ON THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF AN AIR NAVIGATION SERVICE PROVIDER

Article 1

(Subject Matter and Exemption from Application)

- This Rulebook lays down the requirements and procedure for the issuance, amendment, suspension or revocation of a certificate for the provision of air navigation services.
- (2) The requirements laid down in this Rulebook shall not apply to the air navigation services provided to aircraft operating as OAT (Operational Air Traffic).

Article 2

(Terms and Acronyms)

- (1) The terms used in this Rulebook shall have the following meanings:
 - a) Safety regulations: means the applicable regulations in BIH relating to the provision of air navigation services or the discharge of air traffic flow management or airspace management functions, as well as concerning the technical and operational competence and suitability to provide said services and discharge said functions, their safety management, as well as systems, their constituents and associated procedures;
 - b) Safety requirement: means a risk mitigation, defined from the risk mitigation strategy that allows for the achievement of a particular safety objective; safety requirements include organisational, operational, procedural, functional, performance and interoperability requirements or environmental environmental functions;
 - Bosnia and Herzegovina Directorate of Civil Aviation (hereinafter: BHDCA): the competent aviation authority of Bosnia and Herzegovina;
 - d) National Supervisory Authority: means the BHDCA;
 - e) ECAA Agreement (Multilateral Agreement on the Establishment of a European Common Aviation Area): the multilateral agreement between the European Community and its Member States, the Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Republic of Croatia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, the Republic of Iceland, the Republic of Montenegro, the Kingdom of Norway, Romania, the Republic of Serbia and the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (pursuant to Security Council Resolution 1244 of 10 June 1999) on the establishment of a European Common Aviation Area;
 - f) ICAO checklists: Lists to verify compliance with the requirements of the standards laid down in ICAO Annexes;
 - g) Corrective action: an action to eliminate the cause of a detected non-conformity;
 - Non-conformity: means a deficiency in the characteristic, documentation or procedure against applicable regulations or standards;
 - Organisation Exposition: a document describing an organisation and operational activities of an air navigation service provider;

- Organisation: means an air navigation service provider or an entity providing air traffic flow management or airspace management services;
- Safety Policy: means a statement of the organisation's fundamental approach to achieve an acceptable level of safety:
- Safety Monitoring: Systematic activities undertaken to detect changes affecting the provision of air navigation services, aimed at establishing a tolerable level of safety;
- m) Risk Assessment: an evaluation in order to establish whether the achieved or perceived risk is tolerable;
- Process: means a set of interrelated or interacting activities that transforms inputs into outputs;
- Verification: means confirmation, by provision of objective evidence, that specified requirements have been fulfilled;
- p) Verifier: a person who has the relevant professional qualification and work experience in the field that is the subject of verification, and who, above all, is familiar with and understands safety regulatory requirements and assessment techniques when conducting the required analyses, and who is familiar with auditing skills.
- Risk: means the combination of the overall probability or frequency of occurrence of a harmful effect induced by a hazard and the severity of that effect;
- Audit: includes any activity of the BHDCA when establishing and verifying compliance of the organisation that is the subject of the compliance check with the regulatory requirements, including audits and inspections;
- certification: means a procedure to determine an applicant's compliance with the applicable requirements contained in the Aviation Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the regulations enacted on the basis of this Law;
- Certificate for the provision of air navigation services (hereinafter: Certificate): a document issued by the BHDCA as the result of a certification, which confirms that an air navigation service provider meets the requirements for providing one or several air navigation services;
- v) Safety Management System SMS: involves organisation, procedures and an accountability system to establish and maintain an acceptable level of safety within the operations of an air navigation service provider;
- z) SMS Documentation: a set of documents, arising from the organisation's safety policy statements and aimed at achieving its safety objectives, based on which a safety management system (SMS) is developed and documented:
- aa) Certification team: A team of verifiers composed with the goal to verify compliance with the requirements for the provision of air navigation services;
- bb) "Spot check" principle: the principle where individual points are subjected to quick checks instead of the entire group;
- services: means an air navigation service or a set of air navigation services;
- Air navigation services: a generic term meaning the provision of flight information services, air traffic control services, and navigation, communication, surveillance and meteorological services;

- ee) Aircraft: Any machine that can derive support in the atmosphere from the reactions of the air other than the reactions of the air against the earth's surface.
- (2) The acronyms used in this Rulebook have the following meanings:
 - a) AIS Aeronautical information services;
 - b) ANSP Air Navigation Service Provider;
 - c) APMF Application Management Function;
 - d) ATS Air Traffic Services;
 - BHDCA Bosnia and Herzegovina Directorate of Civil Aviation;
 - f) CNS Comunication, Navigation or Surveillance services;
 - g) EASA European Aviation Safety Agency;
 - h) EU European Union;
 - GAT General Air Ttraffic All flights conducted in accordance with the rules and procedures of ICAO;
 - j) ICAO International Civil Aviation Organisation;
 - k) MET Meteorogical Services;
 - l) NSA National Supervisory Authority;
 - m) OAT Operational Air Traffic All flights which do not comply with the GAT rules and for which rules and procedures have been prescribed by the competent national authorities;
 - n) SMS Safety Management System;
 - o) QMS Quality Management System.

(Certificate Issuance Requirements)

To obtain a certificate for the provision of air navigation services, the applicant shall fulfil the requirements laid down in the Rulebook establishing common and specific requirements for the provision of air navigation services (Official Gazette of BIH 101/5), in particular:

- a) the common and specific requirements under Article 4 of the Rulebook, and
- the requirements to obtain a certificate with derogation under Article 5 of the Rulebook.

Article 4

(Letter of Intent)

- (1) An applicant wishing to be certified shall submit to the BHDCA a letter of intent to submit an application for issuance of the certificate (hereinafter: letter of intent), at least 90 and not more than 120 days prior to the planned date of submission of the certification application.
- (2) The applicant shall specify in the letter of intent referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article the air navigation services for which he intends to submit a certification application,
- (3) After receipt of the letter of intent referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article, the BHDCA shall decide on acceptance of the letter of intent within 30 days of the day of receipt and shall inform the applicant accordingly.
- (4) If no further information is required, the BHDCA shall communicate to the submitter of the letter of intent a notice of acceptance of the letter of intent, containing:
 - information about the manner of conducting the certification process;
 - a list of the documents required to be submitted along with a certificate issuance application;

-) the amount of the fee required to be paid.
- (5) Attached to the notice referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article, the BHDCA shall submit to the submitter of a letter of intent:
 - a) a certificate issuance application form, which has been provided in Appendix I of this Rulebook;
 - questionnaires for the verification of compliance with the common and specific requirements laid down in Appendices I, II, III, IV and V of the Rulebook establishing common and specific requirements for the provision of air navigation services;
 - c) ICAO checklists to verify compliance with the requirements of the standards laid down in Appendices II, III, IV and V of the Rulebook establishing common and specific requirements for the provision of air navigation services.
- (6) If additional information is required, the BHDCA shall communicate to the submitter of the letter of intent a request to submit the additional information, including a submission deadline.
- (7) If the submitter of the letter of intent fails to submit additional information within a specified period or does not meet the conditions for the commencement of the certification process, it shall be deemed that the letter of intent has not been submitted at all, about which a special conclusion shall be adopted by the BHDCA.

Article 5

(Application Management Function)

- An Application Management Function (APMF) is a person tasked with communication with the submitter of a letter of intent during the process of certification and recognition of a foreign certificate.
- (2) The Application Management Function shall, in line with his powers, take action in the process and shall be responsible for the management of records resulting from the case.

Article 6

(Certification Application)

- (1) A certification process shall commence following submission of a certificate issuance application.
- (2) The applicant shall submit the application using the form contained in Appendix I of this Rulebook.
- (3) The applicant shall, along with the application, enclose the documents specified in Article 7 of this Rulebook, thus proving compliance with the common and specific requirements.

Article 7

(Documentation to be Enclosed with a Certificate Issuance Application)

An applicant shall enclose the following documents with a certificate issuance application:

- a list and scope of air navigation services that the applicant intends to provide;
- b) an Organisation Exposition, comprising:
 - a statement by the Accountable Manager confirming the applicant's compliance with common and specific requirements, and urging the applicant to maintain continuous compliance with the common and specific requirements, and agreeing that the applicant submits, at BHDCA's request, any additional information required for the purpose of determining compliance;
 - 2) a safety policy document of the applicant;
 - positions and personal names of the applicant's senior managers including their obligations and responsibilities, in particular:

- a description of safety management and a description of the responsibilities for the development and maintenance of the safety management system;
- the obligations, responsibilities and organisation established to ensure active participation of senior managers in safety management;
 - an organisational chart and lines of responsibilities in the areas covered by common requirements;
 - 5) a general overview of human resources;
 - a general overview of facilities, work premises, equipment and appliances;
 - a description of the applicant's compliance with common requirements and how the applicant will remain compliant with common requirements;
- c) completed questionnaires for the verification of compliance with common and specific requirements;
- d) completed ICAO checklists for the verification of compliance with the requirements of the standards laid down in Appendices II, III, IV and V of the Rulebook establishing common and specific requirements for the provision of air navigation services.

(Action following receipt of a Certificate Issuance Application)

- (1) The BHDCA shall, within a maximum of 10 working days after receipt of an application and documentation, confirm to the applicant that the application and documentation have been received or shall, in case of direct delivery, issue an acknowledgement of receipt.
- (2) Following receipt of the application, the BHDCA shall establish a Certification Team (hereinafter: the Team) and designate a Team Leader.
- (3) Members of the Team shall be authorised persons and inspectors in accordance with the Rulebook on Oversight in Civil Aviation.

Article 9

(Assessment of Eligibility of a Certificate Issuance Application)

- (1) Team leader shall, together with Team members, assess the eligibility of an application for issuance of a certificate for the provision of air navigation services in Bosnia and Herzegovina and shall submit a report on the assessment to the Application Management Function.
- (2) The eligibility assessment referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall mean a verification of:
 - a) whether the applicant meets the requirements for certification in Bosnia and Herzegovina in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3) of Article 7 of Appendix I of the Rulebook on the provision of air navigation services in the Single European Sky.
 - whether the certificate issuance application is complete and correct and whether all the required documents have been submitted.
- (3) Following a completed eligibility assessment, the Application Management Function shall notify the applicant:
 - a) that the application has been accepted and that the certification process has been resumed,
 - that it is necessary for the applicant to supplement the application and documentation,
 - that the applicant has been rejected because he is not eligible for certification in Bosnia and Herzegovina.
- (4) In case of an assessment that the application is eligible, the Application Management Function shall, within 21 days following receipt of the application, notify the applicant that the application has been accepted and that the certification process has been resumed. The following items shall be enclosed with the notification:
 - a) a certification plan;
 - b) information about the Team Leader and Team Members;
 - instruction for the payment of the fee for checking compliance with the requirements for the provision of air navigation services. The fee for checking

compliance for the provision of air navigation services should be paid not later than 10 working days following receipt of the notification. The certification process shall not be resumed until the fee has been paid. The amount of the fee for checking compliance with the requirements for the provision of air navigation services has been defined in the Decision on the amounts of fees for the services provided within the scope of responsibility of the Bosnia and Herzegovina Directorate of Civil Aviation.

- (5) In case of an assessment that it is necessary for the applicant to supplement the application and documentation, the Application Management Function shall inform the applicant of the final date for the submission of an updated application and completed documentation.
- (6) If the applicant fails to act in accordance with the provision of paragraph (5) of this Article, the BHDCA shall deal with the application on the basis of available evidence.

Article 10

(Review of Documentation)

- (1) The Team shall assess the application by reviewing the documentation submitted by the applicant.
- (2) The documentation referred to in Article 7 of this Rulebook may be subjected to a further on-site audit.
- (3) With respect to the documentation, the Team:
 - shall seek proof that the applicable common and specific requirements have been implemented appropriately and that proof exists that processes and their implementing rules have been developed;
 - may request written clarification regarding any action, procedure, reference, process etc. and a response to such request shall be deemed an integral part of the documentation accompanying the certification application;
 - c) in the event that it identifies a non-conformity with common and specific requirements, the Team shall request that the applicant elaborate in writing such non-conformity. This will provide the applicant with an additional opportunity to rectify the nonconformity before the assessment is completed or to provide arguments that attest compliance with the common and specific requirements.
- (4) A review may not be limited to the documents specified by the applicant in his Organisation Exposition or in completed Compliance Checklists. The Team may request, via Application Management Function, that additional documents be presented by the applicant, and such documents shall be considered an integral part of the documentation accompanying the certification application.
- (5) If a review of the documentation indicates a possible non-conformity with common and specific requirements in certain parts of the applicant's organisation, such parts of the organisation may be subjected to a further on-site audit. Any other parts of the organisation may be subjected to an on-site audit as well, on the basis of the 'spot check' principle.
- (6) If a review of the documentation establishes that the applicant does not meet common and specific requirements, the Application Management Function shall adopt a decision to reject the application.

Article 11

(Initial Oversight Plan and Programme)

- After establishing that the application and documentation are complete, the Application Management Function shall, on proposal by the Team, adopt an initial oversight plan and programme, which will additionally ascertain if the applicant meets the requirements for issuance of the certificate, and shall submit them to the applicant, not later than 60 days following receipt of complete documentation.
- (2) Prior to commencing initial oversight, the Appliation Management Function and the applicant shall coordinate the dates and dynamics of the initial oversight.

(Initial Oversight)

- Initial oversight includes at least one on-site audit of the applicant's organisation.
- (2) On-site audit areas shall be determined through:
 - a) the information obtained at the documentation review, defining the areas of the applicant's organisation and specific processes to be audited, in order to test the applicant's compliance with a selected set of common and specific requirements (spot checks);
 - the information obtained at the documentation review, in order to verify if the implementation of the applicant's arrangements is in line with the identified intentions (spot checks);
 - information obtained during the documentation review, indicating a possible non-conformity with common and specific requirements;
 - d) other areas of interest (areas that are the subject of onsite audits should not exclusively include the areas audited at the documentation review).
- (3) The selection of audit areas shall take into account the results of previous audits and inspections conducted by the BHDCA within a twenty-four-month period, identifying areas where sufficient level of confidence exists as regards management practices already implemented by the applicant's organisation.
- (4) Requirements to be audited shall be identified in each of the selected areas. The sampling of the requirements in each area should depend upon the processes being verified and the level of confidence obtained by the Team from the documentation review.
- (5) Initial oversight shall be conducted on the principles of auditing.

Article 13

(Facilitation of Initial Oversight)

- (1) The applicant shall make provision for the Team to conduct initial oversight in an unhindered way and to have free access to the facilities, equipment and appliances, as well as insight into any relevant information and requested documents, data, including tours and visits to the applicant's sites, and shall provide the Team with any technical assistance required.
- (2) Members of the Team shall be entitled to perform the following actions in the course of conducting initial oversight:
 - a) look into relevant records, data, procedures and any other materials relevant for the provision of air navigation services;
 - take copies or extracts of such records, data, procedures and other materials;
 - c) request oral explanation on the spot;
 - enter the relevant premises, properties or means of transport.

Article 14

(Assessment Report)

- (1) Following completion of an assessment (documentation review and initial oversight), the Application Management Function shall submit an assessment report, composed by the Team Leader on the basis of individual reports by Team Members, containing the following information:
 - a) general information regarding the initial oversight, composition of the Team, observers and experts engaged during the initial oversight, the objectives and scope of the oversight, and the oversight plan;
 - details relating to the identified non-conformities and their relevance;

- the applicant's responses to the non-conformities identified during spot checks;
- a request to submit a corrective action plan to rectify the identified non-conformities;
- e) conclusions of the assessment, relating to the overall certification process.
- (2) An assessment report shall be composed in two identical originals, one of which shall be submitted to the applicant within 15 days of the completion of the assessment.
- (3) Submission of an assessment report shall constitute completion of the initial oversight.
- (4) The Team Leader shall not proceed with any subsequent assessment steps if the initial oversight has shown that the certification process cannot be completed due to a lack of funds in the applicant's structure, due to applicant's insufficient efforts in ensuring compliance with the applicable common and specific requirements, or due to applicant's inability to ensure compliance with the applicable common and specific requirements. Instead, the case shall be handed over to the Application Management Function with the Team's proposal to reject the application.
- (5) If initial oversight shows that the certification process cannot be completed due to a lack of funds in the applicant's structure, due to applicant's insufficient efforts in ensuring compliance with the applicable common and specific requirements, or due to applicant's inability to ensure compliance with the applicable common and specific requirements, the Application Management Function shall adopt a decision to reject the application.

Article 15

(Corrective Action)

- An applicant shall submit a corrective action plan within 30 days following the date of submission of an assessment report.
- (2) The corrective action plan shall include:
 - a) information about the applicant and the conducted initial oversight;
 - b) a root cause analysis for each non-conformity;
 - short-term activities aimed at immediate removal of non-conformities;
 - d) long-term activities aimed at prevention of future occurrence of similar non-conformities;
 - completion dates for the activities under points c) and d) of this Article;
 - relevant evidence.
- (3) The Team shall assess proposed corrective actions and accept them if they are sufficient to rectify the nonconformities, and the applicant shall carry out the corrective actions within accepted deadlines.
- (4) If a proposed corrective action plan is not acceptable, the Team shall, through Team Leader, notify the Application Management Function accordingly, specify the reasons, request revision of the corrective action plan and specify a deadline to submit the revised plan.
- (5) The Application Management Function shall adopt a decision to reject the application if the applicant:
 - a) fails to submit a corrective action plan within the deadline laid down in paragraph (1) of this Article; or
 - b) fails to implement the corrective actions within accepted deadlines.

Article 16

(Duration of Certification Process)

The BHDCA shall decide on a certificate issuance application within 180 days following the date of submission of the application.

(Completion of the Process)

A certification process shall be completed through adoption of:

- a) conclusions rejecting the certification application;
- b) a decision on the issuance of the certificate; or
- a decision on the rejection of the certificate issuance application.

Article 18

(Notions of Certificate and Certificate Validity)

- (1) The BHDCA shall adopt a decision and issue a certificate to an applicant if the applicant, in the course of the certification process, proves that he fulfills the requirements for issuance of a certificate for the provision of air navigation services.
- (2) The certificate shall be valid for as long as the air navigation service provider remains compliant with the requirements specified in Article 3 of this Rulebook, its replacement, restriction, suspension or revocation.
- (3) Exceptionally, the certificate may be issued for a limited period of time if, for objective reasons, the BHDCA assesses that the level of confidence in the service provider's capability to ensure continuous compliance has been reduced.
- (4) The issued certificate shall be valid for 24 months provided that the BHDCA allows derogations in accordance with Article 5 of the Rulebook establishing common and specific requirements for the provision of air navigation services.
- (5) The issued certificate shall be valid for 12 months provided that the applicant is a newly-established organisation.
- (6) The air navigation services for which certificate issuance applications may be filed have been specified in Appendix II of this Rulebook.
- (7) The BHDCA may issue to the applicant, at his request, individual certificates for each service he wishes to provide or a single certificate for two or more services.
- (8) An applicant who meets the certificate issuance requirements shall pay a fee for issuance of a certificate for the provision of air navigation services. The amount of the fee for issuance of a certificate for the provision of air navigation services has been defined in the Decision on the amounts of fees for the services provided within the scope of responsibility of the Bosnia and Herzegovina Directorate of Civil Aviation.

Article 19

(Contents of the Certificate)

- (1) Pursuant to point 1 of Annex II of Appendix I of the Rulebook on the provision of air navigation services in the Single European Sky, the certificate shall include:
 - the name of the competent aviation authority issuing the certificate,
 - b) the name and address of the applicant,
 - the common requirements for the issuance and validity of the certificate,
 - d) the services for which the certificate is issued,
 - e) the date of issuance of the certificate,
 - f) the validity of the certificate, and
 - g) the applicant' statement of compliance with the common requirements.
- (2) If the BHDCA allows derogations in accordance with Article 5 of the Rulebook establishing common and specific requirements for the provision of air navigation services, the certificate shall be accompanied by an Appendix to the certificate which specifies the nature of the derogation, scope of derogation, legal basis for the derogation, and the BHDCA's obligation to monitor whether the applicant continuously fulfills the requirements under which the derogations have been allowed.
- (3) In accordance with point 2 of Annex II of Appendix I of the Rulebook on the provision of air navigation services in the Single European Sky, additional requirements shall be specified if they are established by the BHDCA at the applicant's request.

(4) The certificate shall be issued on the certificate form provided in Appendix III of this Rulebook.

Article 20

(Recognition of Foreign Certificates)

- (1) The BHDCA shall recognise a certificate issued to a foreign organisation by the national aviation authority of an ECAA country
- (2) The certificate recognition process under paragraph (1) of this Article shall be initiated through an official application by a foreign organisation. In addition to a certificate recognition application, the applicant shall submit a copy of the valid certificate together with a certificate appendix specifying a list of services for which the certificate was issued and any specific conditions, if they exist.
- (3) The BHDCA shall, within 10 days of receipt of an application and documentation, confirm in writing to the applicant that the application and documentation have been received, or shall, in case of direct delivery, issue an acknowledgement of receipt.
- (4) The Application Management Function shall, within 10 days of receipt of an application, send a query, either through an official letter or by e-mail, to the issuing national aviation authority, requesting confirmation that this national aviation authority had issued the certificate that was submitted by the applicant together with a certificate appendix, if any.
- (5) After receipt of a affirmative response from the national aviation authority, the Application Management Function shall, within 10 days of receipt of the response, inform the applicant: that the application and documentation are complete or that it is necessary to supplement the application or documentation, pay the levy and fee for foreign certificate recognition, with a note that the certificate recognition process will not be resumed until the fee has been paid.
- (6) After establishing that the application and documentation are complete and the fee has been paid, the Application Management Function shall, within 15 days, adopt a decision on the recognition of the foreign certificate for the provision of air navigation services, and shall communicate it to the applicant.
- (7) If the Application Management Function assesses that the applicant does not meet the certificate recognition requirements, he shall adopt a decision to reject the application and communicate it to the applicant.

Article 21

(Renewal of the Certificate)

- A certificate holder shall file with the BHDCA an application to renew the certificate six months before expiration of the certificate's validity period.
- (2) The BHDCA may renew the certificate without performing additional audits provided that the certificate holder has proved during oversight carried out recently that he has remained in compliance with common and specific requirements.
- (3) Based on the results of the oversight carried our recently, the BHDCA may decide to perform an additional on-site audit.
- (4) In the case referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article, the Application Management Function shall develop a dedicated Certification plan for the purpose of renewing the certificate, describing the entire process.

Article 22

(Suspension or Revocation of the Certificate)

- (1) If the BHDCA, during oversight of a certificate holder, issues a 'Category 1' finding, or changes a 'Category 2' finding to a 'Category 1' finding, the BHDCA shall take urgent and appropriate measures in order to prohibit or restrict the applicant's activity or shall take measures to revoke, partially or fully restrict or suspend the certificate.
- (2) The BHDCA shall adopt a decision on the measures taken under paragraph (1) of this Rulebook, and shall communicate it to the certificate holder.
- (3) When deciding on the measures to be taken, the BHDCA shall consider the effectiveness and proportionality of the

- measures and shall observe the obligation to seamlessly provide safe services to users.

 The BHDCA shall inform EASA and the Ministry of
- (4) The BHDCA shall inform EASA and the Ministry of Communication and Transport of Bosnia and Herzegovina of its decision to revoke or suspend a certificate, with an explanation of the reasons for it.

(BHDCA Procedures and Instructions)

The BHDCA shall develop procedures and instructions by which it shall assess an applicant's compliance with the requirements of applicable laws and regulations.

Article 24

(Confidentiality of Information and Documentation)

- (1) Any documents submitted with a certificate issuance application or submitted subsequently for inspection, as well as information collected during oversight activities, shall be considered as business or professional secret, unless prescribed otherwise by national or international regulations.
- (2) The BHDCA shall protect the confidentiality of information and documents, in particular:

- a) confidential information about air navigation service providers, their professional relations or their cost components;
- safety- and security-related information, and any other information that may be detrimental to an air navigation service provider.

Article 25 (Repeal)
